

Financial Information 2025

The EU EYE (European Alliance for Vision Research & Ophthalmology) is registered in Belgium under Belgian law as an international non-profit organisation with registration number 0643482261. The EU EYE is an alliance of organisations representing subspecialties of ophthalmology disseminating strategic information to its member organisations (email alerts and specific briefings on emerging topics, regular policy updates, training materials).

The funding of EU EYE's advocacy activities at EU level is based on a membership business model. Member dues are calculated on the basis of number of events held by each member organisation and number of event participants. Membership fees are paid by member organisations on a schedule matching their calendar of events. The total contribution of member dues represents 100% of the total income. The budget covers core activities of interest representation at EU institutions, bodies and agencies aiming: to shape EU policy for people-centred eye health care in Europe; to increase awareness about research needs in vision science and ophthalmology; and to support its members in specific areas of policy when the need arise.

Operational Budget

In 2025, the total income of EU EYE was €67,542.5. Contributions per society are shown below. The biggest contributor is the EURETINA representing 74.71 % of the total EU EYE income.
